In the recent Parent Questionnaire several families asked about Cycling Training for the children. Having encouraged PC Speariett to run the course we have, unfortunately, had very little response. He has delayed the start of the training until next week. It will take place on Wednesday evenings (or there is another group running on Thursday evenings if that is easier) and will run for approximately 5 weeks. The sessions will begin at 5pm and last for one and a half hours. They will take place at Underfleet Car Park, Seaton (where an initial assessment will take place) and then onto the roads in Seaton. PC Speariett is also hoping to hold an extra session, at the end of the course, on Branscombe roads. The course will be fully risk assessed.

Children must be 10 years or older and they should bring a well maintained bike and a cycle helmet. Reflective jackets will be provided. There is no charge for the course.
