**Free School Meals.**

The application process for free school meals has changed. We would encourage parents to apply if you receive any of the following :-

- Employment Support Allowance (Income Related)
- Income Support (IS)
- Child Tax Credit without Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable income (as assessed by HMR&C) of less than £16,040
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- Guaranteed Element of State Pension Credit.

If you have recently become unemployed but are still receiving working Tax credits, you may be entitled to free school meals. Please call into the office for further information.
