Dear Parents,

The children attended the Remembrance Service today at the war memorial. Class 2 read some very moving poems and the children planted the crosses and laid a wreath. As always, I was very proud of how respectful the children were.

It was lovely to see so many families at the Bonfire Party on Saturday night. The youth group had done a brilliant job organising the evening. The food was delicious and the bonfire and firework display was spectacular.

You are probably aware that several unions are taking industrial on Wednesday 30th November. Members of staff at Branscombe will be supporting their unions and taking strike action on this date. Unfortunately, this will mean that school will have to close on this date. Many parents will be able to testify to the conscientious and caring nature of the staff at our School and will understand how loath we are to disrupt children's education, for a second day this calendar year. We take our responsibilities as teachers very seriously. However, the proposed changes in the teachers' Pension Scheme are so drastic that we are concerned not only for own situation but also for those just joining the profession or considering entering it. We appreciate that it may be necessary to adjust or adapt the present pension plan in the light of the current economic situation, but we feel that the scheme has been downgraded to such an extent that it goes well beyond any measured response to the present financial stringencies, even allowing for changes in life expectancy. Most of us have never considered such action until this current issue and the headteacher's union has no history of striking at all.

Our school travel plan asks that parents park in the Village Hall and walk children up the school path, which was built specifically for this purpose, therefore ensuring the safety of children.
