- Depending on age the children could write out the recipe or it could be typed and emailed to school. Don't forget to give the recipe a name and to put the child's name and age on it.
- The recipe needs to have the ingredients, method and a short paragraph about why you like it.
- Have a practice making it at home and take some photos of the children making the recipe, the finished product and eating it! The photos are vital to follow the printer's format. Please bring these into school to be scanned or email them to admin@branscombe.devon.sch.uk . Emails should clearly say they are for the recipe book, which recipe and again which child.
- All recipes and photos need to be in school by 31st October so you will have half term to practise your chef skills!
