
# BRANSCOMBE C OF E PRIMARY SCHOOL **NEWSLETTER 12 / 13 12**

## **Dear Parents**

It was lovely that both KS2 classes of The Jubilee Federation joined together at Branscombe yesterday for their Roman Banquet. The children had made a real effort with their dressing up some wearing togas and some as Roman Soldiers. During the day the children made bread and stuffed dormice (with dates and fondant icing). They sampled dried and fresh figs as well as defrutum which is a reduction of figs in grape juice. They also made potage from lentils, leeks, coriander, honey, defrutum, wine vinegar and olive oil.







In the afternoon the two schools worked together on Jubilee Federation Mosaics and sampled the potage and a selection of dried and fresh fruits. Some children completed Roman word searches whilst others played Roman games.

I would like to say a big thank you to all the staff for organising the day, from the teachers who planned everything to the teaching assistants and meal time assistants who worked with children from both schools during the day.

I would also like to thank the children for working together really well and for making the day a real success – well done!
