

Dear Parents,

Welcome back to school. We all hope you had a super holiday. Over the last couple of weeks our builders worked really hard to ensure that class one was ready for us this week. Last summer we discovered that parts of the original floor were rotten and so it has been stripped right back to the soil underneath and rebuilt.

I would like to thank the children and staff of Class 2 for the super work they produced about World War 1 for the Branscombe Project Exhibition in the Branoc Hall over the holidays. When I visited the exhibition I received some lovely feedback about the children's display.

As some of you may know I accidentally set off the fire alarm before school one morning this week. Although this was completely unintentional, it did raise some interesting conversations. We realised that at 8.50 we were unaware of who would be in the building, other than those registered for Breakfast Club, as normal registration has not taken place by that time. I have discussed this with the Devon County Council Health and Safety team and we are going to review our early morning procedures as a staff. The exceptions to this will be Breakfast Club children who have a separate register and those children in Reception who do come in early but are 'handed across' to Mr Ford. We will explain the reasons for this to the children as well.

## African Garden building day - Thursday 1st May

• Thanks to all who have agreed to provide materials for this. We are still in need of quite a few things so if you are able to provide anything, even if it is just the use of some tools for the day **or if you are able to help us on the day** let us know ASAP.

We are still in need of:

Stones, bricks or wood for the walls

1.5m canes / sticks

**Garden twine** 

Chicken wire or willow / hazel bendy twigs or to weave the central basket Compost

Spare spades, forks or trowels to borrow just for the day

- If you have already agreed to provide materials, please can you drop them off directly to the field, next Monday 28<sup>th</sup> April (or as soon as possible after that date). For your convenience the gate between the field and the lane will be opened so that materials can be left at the end of the field.
- All children will need to come to school on Thursday wearing appropriate gardening clothing and footwear that can get dirty but that will keep them warm and dry.
