

### **Playground Safety**

Please could we remind parents and children that the pupils should not bring their own balls to school. The playground is too small for the children to use hard balls and so balls we have purchased have been specifically selected. Children are not permitted to play ball games before and after school, this is because parents are walking through the playground, often with babies and toddlers. There have been a couple of incidents recently when children have been hit by hard balls and so we would appreciate parents supporting us with this. Please could you also help us to encourage children not to climb on the walls around the playground for safety reasons.

### **Snail and the Whale Theatre Trip**

The PTFA have kindly suggested paying for the whole school to attend The Snail and the Whale at Northcott Theatre on Thursday  $20^{th}$  December.
