


BRANSCOMBE C OF E PRIMARY SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 10/29 Friday 7th May 2010

NUT and NAHT Boycott of Key Stage 2 SATS in 2010

You may have seen in the news recently that two of the teaching unions are asking their members to boycott the Key Stage 2 SATS which are taking place next week. At Branscombe the tests will take place as usual. This decision was made in consultation with other schools in the Sidmouth Learning Community. Whilst the local headteachers all fully support the reasons behind the NUT and NAHT's boycott we recognise all the hard work that teachers and children have put into the preparation for the tests as well as the expectations of parents and children that the tests should go ahead this year.
