Bikeability

For many years I have tried to arrange Bikeability training at the school. However, because the roads around the village don't include all the situations required for the award (e.g. roundabout, give way signs) we have never succeeded in providing this for children. Recently I have spoken with some people linked to Bikeability and we have talked about having a 'Cycling Promotion' week in school from the 2nd to 6th July. We hope to promote safe cycling by talking about road safety and inviting parents to have cycle maintenance checks. During the week we hope to take the Year 5 and 6 children to an area where the Bikeability award can be done, but also to teach them how to ride in the Branscombe lanes as we feel this is a very important part of the training as it's where many of the children are likely to ride.

The week is very much in the planning stages at the moment but it would be helpful to know how many Year 5 and Year 6 children would like to take part in the training. Even if they have done Bikeability as an outside school course they could still do the Branscombe village training. The children will need their own bike and helmet to take part.
