## **Geranium Competition**

The children are bringing home a small geranium plant today. These have been donated by Otter Nurseries and the children can take part in their 'Geranium Growing Competition'. In the school the children have planted the geraniums in the compost provided by the garden centre. There is a pink slip with this newsletter explaining how the plants should now be looked after at home. The garden centre would encourage children to look after their plant on a daily basis, e.g. checking dryness of the compost, removing fading or dead flowers and giving plant food to encourage more blooms. The plants **must not** be re-potted.

To be entered for the competition parents and children need to take their plant to Otter Nurseries on Sunday 13th July by 1pm. Judging will take place at 1.30pm and winners announced at 2.15pm. Only plants in their original pot will be judged.

The best entry from each school will be awarded a £10 Otter Nurseries Voucher. The overall winner will receive £100 worth of Otter Gift Vouchers for their school and £30 for the child. All entries will receive a prize and of course, praise for taking part. We hope you will want to take part!
