

Capital Budget

For several years now schools have received an annual amount of money to address school ICT needs and building projects. Unlike our main school budget we have been able to carry the underspend from this 'capital' budget across financial years so that larger projects could be saved for.

The latest government has changed the way this 'capital' money is allocated. We now receive less money each year in individual schools. Instead, the county council are in control of a budget for backlog premises issues identified in school asset management plans e.g. improving the heating system at our partner school in Broadhembury. The other change is that we are no longer to save up across as many financial years.

Branscombe School has an asset management plan which is reviewed every year by the county council's surveying team NPS Southwest. The areas of most concern identified within this were considered a priority by governors.

Therefore, over the summer, improvements will be made to spend the remaining money we have saved over the last few years to ensure none of our allocation is taken back into the 'central pot'. These works will include internal decoration, repointing to the stone walls, flat roof works, installation of a storage shed for PE equipment and refurbishment to the school office.
