

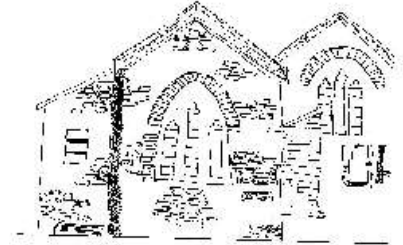

Dear Parents,

I have been in contact this week with contractors from South West Water and DCC regarding a road closure that is taking place between 3rd November 2014 and 27th February 2015. The closure is taking place from Higher Barn to The Old Cider House. I have attached a letter and map regarding this which I was given by the contractors. This explains a one way system which they are putting in place. However, this is a long way round and I do have concerns that many people will use Northern Lane (the lane on which the school is situated) as their alternative route.

I have asked DCC to provide additional signage to highlight that there is a school and to drive with care. They have agreed to do this. I have also asked that the one way route is a priority for gritting in the bad weather. Apparently this is not possible, however, I will continue to ask for this due to this route being much steeper than the road that is being closed.

If you have any further concerns regarding the road closure and its effect on the children at school please let me know and I will pass your comments on to the teams that I have been in communication with.

Please don't forget to allow extra time for your journey to school on the first day back after half term (Tuesday 4th November).
