

Cycling Week

Week commencing 2nd July we will be focussing on cycling. On the Monday morning we will have the police and road safety experts in talking to the children about cycling and keeping themselves safe. There will also be the opportunity to have bike maintenance checks so any child can bring their bike to school on Monday to take advantage of this. For the rest of the week the year 5 and 6 children (who returned their consent forms) will be involved in cycling practice that will help them learn the necessary skills to cycle in busier town situations but also around the lanes of Branscombe. Consent forms must be returned to school by Monday.

Monday - Bikes may be brought to school for maintenance checks.

Tuesday – Involved Year 5 and 6 children please bring bikes and helmets to school. Cycling will take place on the Tennis Courts in Branscombe. Bikes will be stored overnight at school.

Wednesday - Involved Year 5 and 6 children will be cycling in Sidford. Bikes will be transported from Branscombe to Sidford and stored in Sidford overnight. Children need to be at school promptly in the morning so that parent volunteers can transport children to Sidford. Children will return to school for the end of the usual school day. Thursday - As Wednesday. Bikes will be transported from Sidford back to Branscombe at the end of the day.

Friday morning - the involved Year 5 and 6 children will be cycling in Branscombe. Bikes to be collected from School at the end of the day.

Children taking part will need a packed lunch for the Tuesday and Wednesday and must have cycle helmets, a waterproof jacket and sun cream.

Class 1 trip to Seaton Nature Reserve

On Thursday Class 1 will be going to Seaton Nature Reserve. Children will need to be dropped off at Seaton Cemetery Car Park at 9am at and collected from the Cemetery car park at 3pm. All children will need a packed lunch, a full water bottle, a waterproof jacket, sunhat and sun cream. A letter and permission form will be sent home today.

Open evening

On Monday 9th July we will be holding an open evening for all parents. There are no appointments as it is a drop in event where you will be able to see the classroom displays and your child's work from this academic year. The evening also provides an opportunity, if you wish, to discuss your child's report with the class teacher. These will be sent out next week. We look forward to seeing you. The school will be open from 3.15pm until 5.30pm

On Thursday 12th July all parents are welcome to join us from 1pm for the torch procession from school to the Village Hall and around the field. This will be followed by games from Ancient Greece - weather permitting. We will keep you informed regarding the weather but please call if you are in doubt.
